Four separate Sealed Bids for 2018 Model Year Public Service Vehicles, one for vehicles manufactured by the Ford Motor Company, one for vehicles manufactured by the Chevrolet Company, one for vehicles manufactured by Dodge Motor Company, and one for vehicles manufactured by Toyota for various cities and towns and others in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts under the authority of Chapter 7, section 22B and Chapter 30B of the Massachusetts General Laws will be received by the Plymouth County Commissioners Office, 44 Obery Street, Plymouth, MA 02360 no later than **2:00 p.m. Thursday, June 22, 2017**

Bidders must submit two (2) copies of their Bid with original signatures in appropriate places on each copy, along with a Corporate Vote, a Certificate of Non-Collusion, a Certificate of Tax Compliance and a Bid Bond, and other documents described in the Invitation for Bid documents. The Bid must be received by the Plymouth County Commissioners at their office no later than **2:00 p.m. June 22, 2017**. The clock located in the main administration office will be the official time piece. All Bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids must be received in a sealed envelope clearly marked in the lower left hand corner “Public Service Vehicles- Ford”, “Public Service Vehicles- Chevrolet”, “Public Service Vehicles- Dodge”, or “Public Service Vehicles-Toyota, whichever is appropriate for that Bid.
