A regular meeting of the Plymouth County Commissioners was called to order at 10:00 a.m. at the Halifax Town Hall, Selectmen's Meeting Room, 499 Plymouth Street, Halifax, MA. Meeting Minutes-June 9, 2015

Commissioners will review his job performance to consider an increase in salary to \$75,000. Commissioner Hanley seconded.
